The Community Support Program (CSP) in Lebanon



CSP is a **\$100 million**, **seven-year** initiative designed to provide a broad range of support to underserved and vulnerable communities.



CSP is improving the delivery of essential services and enhancing economic opportunities, primarily in Lebanon's **North**, **South**, and **Beqaa Valley** regions.



In addition to CSP's regions of focus, the program may consider interventions in other parts of Lebanon, depending on **needs and priorities**.

Technical Assistance and Capacity Building

- Task Order 3 is the Chemonics Contract with USAID, under CSP, that delivers technical assistance and capacity building
- It is a 5-year mechanism (2019 2024), with a total value of USD million 10.5
- It provides capacity building support to other CSP technical components TO2, TO4, and TO5 through working with more than 100 communities to improve locals know how and sustainability of CSP interventions





How do we Function?



CSP TO (2/4/5) receives approval for project/activity

Relevant TO informs TO3 to design technical assistance interventions relevant to the community and assistance provided

TO3 profiles the beneficiary community/institution to check ability, readiness, willingness for capacity building.



TO3 designs a TAAR (Technical Assistance Assessment Report) that details the:

Situation Analysis, Required Technical Assistance, targeted outcomes, outputs, activities, monitoring and evaluation targets, and Budget

TO3 submits TAAR to USAID for approval



As TAAR is approved, TO3 either opens an RFP/RFA for implementation, or directly contracts with an existing service provider/ short term consultant
